In reference to D.O.No.11016/3/2019-NHM-II (Part-4) dated 10th March, 2021 issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India regarding the continuation of all ongoing activities (including Human Resource) approved under various programmes of NHM on existing rates and terms and conditions in 2020-21, accordingly sanction is hereby accorded to release of Grants-in-aid **Rs.4121.00 Lac (Rupees Forty One Crore and Twenty One Lac only)** under Health System Strengthening on account of Remuneration (including incentives to doctors working in difficult area, EPF, etc.) for Doctors, Paramedical and Other Staff (including outsourced manpower i.e. Data Entry Operators/Support Staff) engaged under NHM for the year 2021-22. 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
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Accordingly, the above sanctioned GIA is hereby electronically transferred to the official bank accounts of your District Health Societies through PFMS/e-transfer.

The Grants-in-Aid is released subject to the following conditions:

1. That the sanctioned funds are to be utilized only for the Remuneration (*including incentives to doctors working in difficult area, EPF, etc.*) of Doctors, Paramedical and Other Staff i.e. Data Entry Operators/Support Staff (outsourced) engaged under NHM, strictly as per the rates and terms & conditions contained in the District Budget Sheets for the financial year 2020-21 till the approval from MoH&FW, GoI for the financial year 2021-22 and as per the guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI after observing all codal formalities required under rules.
2. That the District shall not utilize these funds for any other activities without approval of State Health Society.
3. That the payment to the contractual manpower is to be made after appraising their performance.
4. That the District Health Societies shall accept the funds on PFMS portal after confirming the same from their bank accounts and subsequently release funds to the Block/downward health institutions *within two (2) days* through the same portal/ e-transfer under intimation to the State Health Society, NHM, J&K. Further, Districts/Blocks shall also ensure that all the expenditure are to be uploaded on PFMS portal and implement the EAT module of PFMS.
5. That the District Health Societies ensure that all the payments for Contractual Staff are to be made only through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode and *submit the DBT payments details to the State Health Society by or before 5th of next month mandatorily for further updating DBT Bharat portal.*
6. That the timely submission of Concurrent Audit Report & compliance to the observations reported in the Statutory Audit Report.
7. That the monthly FMR is to be submitted in customized Tally ERP to the State Health Society duly authenticated by the competent authority on regular basis.
8. That the Physical/Financial achievements are to be sent to the State Health Society duly authenticated by the competent authority on regular basis.
9. That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Books, Ledgers, Assets created, complete address of beneficiaries and other relevant records are to be maintained at all levels strictly as per the financial guidelines by MoH&FW, GoI.
10. That the accounts of the District Health Societies/grantee institutions/organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI and whenever the society is called upon to do so.
