4. That the proper record of candidates and other relevant records are to be maintained for inspection of any visiting team from Central/State Government.

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5. That the accounts of the grantee/organization shall be open to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI, whenever the grantee/Society is called upon to do so.
