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**Subject: Constitution of State & District Level Family Planning Indemnity Sub Committee.**

**Government Order No.:- 744 -HME of 2015  
Dated:- 01-12-2015**

In continuation to Govt order No.685-HME of 2015 datedt.14-10-2015, sanction is hereby accorded to the constitution of:-

- 1) State Family Planning Indemnity Sub Committee (SFPIS) from the "State Level Quality Assurance Committee (SQAC)", which would redress, dispose and disburse claims/ complaints received through the District Quality Assurance Committee (DQAC), to the district health society as per procedure and time frame laid down in the Family Planning Indemnity Scheme (FPIS) manual.
- 2) District Family Planning Indemnity Sub Committees (DFPIS), in each district of the State from the District Level Quality Assurance Committee (DQAC), which would process claims received from the clients and complaints/claims lodged against the surgeons and accredited facilities, as per procedures and time frame laid down in the Family Planning Indemnity Scheme (FPIS) manual.

The composition alongwith terms of reference of these committees would be as under:-

**A) State Family Planning Indemnity Sub Committee (SFPIS).**

**Composition:**

1. Mission Director, NRHM (Vice Chairperson)
2. Director Family Welfare J&K (Convener)
3. Additional/ Joint Director (FW)/ Dy. Director Family Welfare/ equivalent, designated by the State Govt. as the Nodal Officer for the Family Planning Indemnity subcommittee Cell (Member Secretary).
4. One Empanelled Gynecologist (from Public Institutions):  
Dr. Bushra Farooq JLNH Hospital Srinagar and Dr. Anil Mehta, DH Reasi
5. One Empanelled Surgeon (from Public Health Institutions):  
Dr. Abdul Hamid Mir, DH Anantnag & Dr. Rakesh Gupta, DH Kathua

### **Terms of Reference:-**

1. Visit both public and private facilities providing family planning services in the state to ensure implementation of national standards
2. Review and report deaths/complications attributable to sterilization in the State.
3. Review and report conception due to failure of sterilization in the state.
4. Give directions on implementations of measures to improve quality of sterilization service.
5. Review the implementation of the National Family Planning Indemnity Scheme/Payment of Compensation in the state.
6. The "State Family Planning Indemnity Subcommittee" would meet every six months or sooner if warranted.
7. At least three members would constitute the quorum of this sub-committee.

### **B) District Family Planning Indemnity Sub Committees (DFPIS).**

#### **Composition:**

1. District Collector (Chairperson)
2. Chief Medical Officer (Convener)
3. District Family Welfare Officer (Member Secretary)
4. One Empanelled Gynecologist (from public Institution).
5. One Empanelled Surgeon (from public institution)

#### **Terms of Reference:-**

1. Conducting medical audit of all deaths related to sterilization and sending reports to the State Quality Assurance Committee office.
2. Collecting information on all hospitalization cases related to complications following sterilization, as well as sterilization failure.
3. Reviewing all static institutions i.e. Government and accredited Private NGOs and selected camps providing sterilization services for quality care as per the standards and recommend remedial actions for institutions not adhering with standards.
4. Review, report and process compensation claims for onward submission to the SQAC under the National Family Planning Indemnity Scheme for cases of deaths, complications and failures attributable to male and female sterilization procedures.
5. In case, a facility reports a sterilization related death, the convener of the DQAC should inform the convener of the SQAC within 24 hours. Death audit needs to be undertaken by the DQAC and report sent to the state with a copy to the Govt. of India, within one month of the death being reported.

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6. The "District Family Planning Indemnity Subcommittee" would meet every three months or sooner if warranted.
7. At least three members should constitute the quorum of this sub-committee.
