Accordingly, the funds are hereby electronically transferred through PFMS/e-transfer into the official bank account of your District Health Society.


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The Grant-in-Aid is released subject to the following conditions:

1. That the above sanctioned funds are exclusively meant for Internal Assessment & Peer Assessment of HWCs & PHC-HWCs under Kayakalp Programme of Quality Assurance and to be utilized strictly as per guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI and after observing all codal formalities required under rules. ***In case of any query, please contact to the Programme Manager, Quality Assurance, NHM, J&K.***
2. That the District Health Society shall accept the funds on PFMS portal after confirming from the bank account and subsequently releases funds to the health facilities on the same portal and also ensure timely uploading of expenditure on the PFMS portal.
3. That the timely submission of Concurrent Audit Report & compliance to the observations of Statutory Auditor to be done.
4. That the FMR should be submitted in customized Tally ERP to the State Health Society on regular basis.
5. That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Book, Ledger, Assets and other relevant record are to be maintained for inspection of any visiting team Central/State Govt.
6. That the monthly Statements of Expenditure and Utilisation Certificate are to be sent to the State Health Society regularly.
7. That the accounts of the grantee/institution shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India under the provisions of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India or whenever the society is called upon to do so.
