- That no diversion/reappropriation of funds is permissible without approval of the Competent Authority.
- 3. That the funds shall be utilized to fill up the gaps to deal with mental health and also ensure that there may not be duplication of similar activities from the other source.

- That the statement of expenditure alongwith Utilization Certificate in GFR format form 12(C) be provided to this office.
- 5. That the accounts of the grantee shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, whenever the society is called upon to do so.
