The Grant-in-Aid released is subject to the following conditions:

That the sanctioned funds are to be utilized only for the incentives to ASHAs and remuneration (including incentive of doctors serving in difficult areas) of manpower hired under NHM for the financial year 2016-17, strictly as per the same rates, terms & conditions contained in the Budget Sheet and as per the guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI after observing all codal formalities required under rules.





That it shall be ensured that various physical indicators including JSY, Institutional Deliveries, RKS meeting, etc. should be regularly uploaded on HMIS/MCTS portals without fail.

That the incentives to Medical Officers serving in difficult areas will be released alongwith

That the incentive to the ASHAs & Doctors are to be paid only after verification of Physical & Financial work done by the BPMUs duly certified by concerned Block Medical Officer.

That the funds released under head ASHAs' invectives & remuneration cannot be utilized for

That the payments to ASHAs on account of incentives are to be made by Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode through PFMS portal only, as per the directions of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI. It shall also be ensured that payment of ASHAs' incentives are not to be made by any other mode like e-transfer/ Account Payee Cheque, etc.

That the District Health Societies shall immediately release the funds further in favour of Blocks under intimation to the State Health Society, NHM, J&K and ensure that all the blocks shall disburse the ASHAs' incentives and remuneration (including incentive of Doctors serving in difficult areas) of manpower hired under NHM upto ending Oct, 2016, and report expenditures

under respective heads to the State Health Society.

That the District Health Societies shall accept the funds on the portal of PFMS after confirming same from their bank accounts and subsequently release the funds to blocks similarly on the said portal.

That the timely submission of Concurrent Audit Report & compliance to the observations raised

in the Statutory Audit Report is to be done.

10. That the FMR should be submitted in customized Tally ERP to the State Health Society on

11. That the Physical/Financial achievements are to be sent to the State Health Society on regular

12. That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Books, Ledgers, Assets created, complete address of beneficiaries and other relevant records are to be maintained at all levels.

That the accounts of the District Health Societies shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and Internal Audit by Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI, whenever the society is called upon to do so.
